- 9. The tenderer shall quote the rate Branch wise on basis of delivery at Mandi points/storage points exclusive of all taxes, duties, levies, fees etc.

- 10. The offer of the Tenderer shall remain valid for a period of 45 (forty-five) days from the date of opening of the tender for acceptance.
- 11. The successful Tenderer shall be required to execute agreement with TDCCOL within 7 days of receipt of the intimation/acceptance order for allotted quantity. At the time of execution of agreement, the party has to deposit **Security Money** which is 25 % of the total Sale Value. After adjustment of EMD, the party has to deposit the balance amount towards Security Money. After procurement of the stock on receipt of intimation from TDCCOL, the party shall deposit the Sale Value of the stock within 7 days and will lift the stock simultaneously with the procurement. The Security Money of the party will be adjusted at the concluding part of the deal.

SPECIFICATION OF TAMARIND WITH SEED

A) General Characteristic: -

- 1. Tamarind (with seed) shall be obtained from Tamarindus indica L. after removal of mater covering from the mature and ripe fruits.
- 2. General Requirements: -
 - Tamarind (with seed) shall be mature and ripe and have characteristic
 - The color shall be pale yellow to brown.
 - Tamarind (with seeds) shall be free from rancid taste and musty odor.
 - Tamarind (with seed) shall be free from external moisture or any other deleterious substance.

B) Special Characteristic:

1	Moisture content percent by (Max)	22.00
2	Foreign matter (Organic and Inorganic percent by weight (Max)	5.00

Definition:

- a) Organic extraneous matter consists of vegetable matters of the plants other than the Tamarind pods and its seeds.
